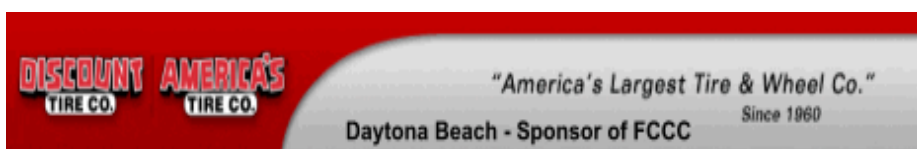

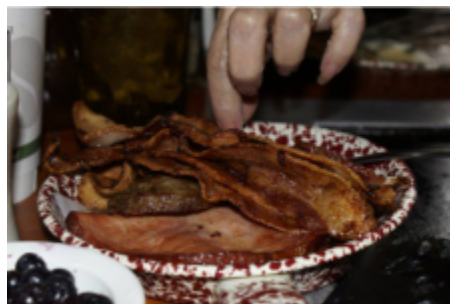
Dad's was a big hit at The Oceanside Beach Bar and Grill. We had 37 members attend Dinner. Another great pick from our social Director, Marsha.

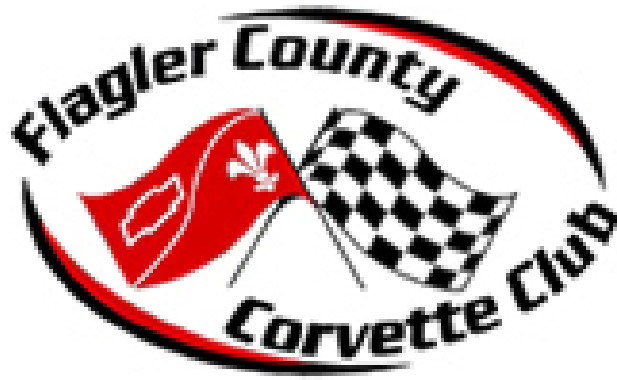
