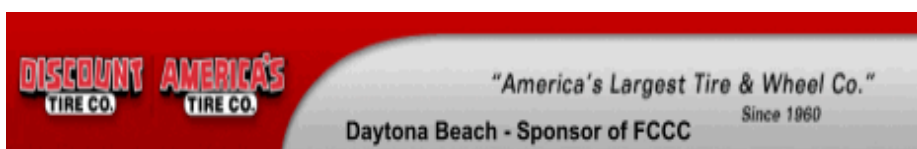
First Friday at Flagler has been a mixed bag as we have had two rain outs in a row. We can try again next month.

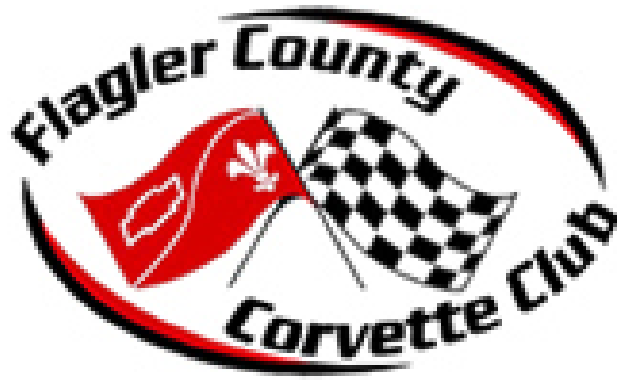
