

## FLAGLER COUNTY CORVETTE CLUB CARAVAN GUIDELINES

In order to ensure a safe and controlled caravan the following guidelines are implemented:

- 1. At the minimum the lead car and the last car should have 2-way radios set to a common channel, usually 5 sub 0.
- 2. Even if you have a radio you should also carry your cell phone. A list of the caravan participants and their cell phone numbers will be provided before leaving.
- 3. Printed directions will also be provided prior to leaving.
- 4. Use headlights.
- 5. The posted speed limit will be observed.
- 6. Should the caravan become split by traffic lights or other obstruction the first car stopped by the obstruction that is radio equipped should advise the leading cars of the delay. The lead cars shall remain on the road at a safe speed allowing the others to catch up.
- 7. A pit stop (if needed) will be set up by the leader. However, if a stop is necessary, notify the leader.
- 8. In the event of a car breakdown the caravan leader shall make the decision to stop or continue on. (Do not backup on highway).
- 9. If a member has signed up for an event but cannot attend, please call a member of the caravan or caravan leader at least 24 hours in advance. This will eliminate unnecessary delays before the caravan departs.
- 10. Starting place for FCCC caravans will be announced by the leader.
